TIME FRAME KEY

Short = now - end of 2021

Medium = end of 2022

Long = beyond 2022

Parameters: ask ppl to do public demonstrations followed by convos around gun violence

group boots on the ground - res + nypd together to engage convos

Priority Categories in Application: Supporting farms impacted by gun violence, healing spaces, engaging mothers

Scholarships

Data / Participatory Research Project to understand causes, not just act.

accountability system amongst peers

Theater- using acting to talk about issue

Parade - then break off to Mental Health, have bbq event, talk about trauma, gun violence (Castle Hill). Open up a heavy convo through a lighter entry point

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Courteous, professional and respectful interactions between law enforcement and community

Improve day to day relationships between community members & police

Intergen healing & relationship building about experience with the police

Noise complaint: NCOs working in Patterson. If 311 call --> responding patrol officers go up to group ask them to turn it off --> most often works, no summons/removal of sound device needed.

Seniors can get together and start dancing together when loud music playing

peacemaking

NYPD intergen mtgs / workshops about alternatives to 311
